


Order of Seal, Trumpet and Bowl Judgments

The Seal Judgments

- 1st Seal: white horse - appearance of the antichrist (Revelation 6:1–2)
- 2nd Seal: red horse - great warfare (Revelation 6:3–4)
- 3rd Seal: black horse – great famine (Revelation 6:5–6)
- 4th Seal: pale green horse – death by sword, hunger, plague, beasts (Revelation 6:7–8)
- 5th Seal: martyrdom of believers in Christ (Revelation 6:9–11)
- 6th Seal: cataclysmic events in heaven and on earth (Revelation 6:12–14). Those who survive the six seals cry out to the mountains and rocks, “Fall on us and hide us from the face of him who sits on the throne and from the wrath of the Lamb! For the great day of his wrath has come, and who can stand?” (Revelation 6:16–17).



Order of Seal, Trumpet and Bowl Judgments


Revelation 7:1-3

- Rev 7:1 After this I saw four angels standing at the four corners of the earth, holding back the four winds of the earth, that no wind might blow on earth or sea or against any tree.
- Rev 7:2 Then I saw another angel ascending from the rising of the sun, with the seal of the living God, and he called with a loud voice to the four angels who had been given power to harm earth and sea,
- Rev 7:3 saying, “Do not harm the earth or the sea or the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.”

Revelation 7:4-8

- Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of the sealed, 144,000, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:
- Rev 7:5 12,000 from the tribe of **Judah** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Reuben**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Gad**,
- Rev 7:6 12,000 from the tribe of **Asher**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Naphtali**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Manasseh**,
- Rev 7:7 12,000 from the tribe of **Simeon**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Levi**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Issachar**,
- Rev 7:8 12,000 from the tribe of **Zebulun**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Joseph**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Benjamin** were sealed.

Revelation 7:9-12

- Rev 7:9 After this I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands,
- Rev 7:10 and crying out with a loud voice, “Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!”
- Rev 7:11 And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God,
- Rev 7:12 saying, “Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! Amen.”

Three Levels of Heavenly Praise Before the Throne and the Lamb

Revelation 5

- 1st Level (v.8-9) - the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb saying, "Worthy are you to take the scroll and to open its seals, for you were slain, and by your blood you ransomed people for God from every tribe and language and people and nation.
- 2nd Level (v.11-12) - the voice of many angels, numbering myriads of myriads and thousands of thousands saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!"
- 3rd Level (v.13) - every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and in the sea, and all that is in them, saying, "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and might forever and ever!"

Revelation 7

- 3rd Level (v. 9-10) - a great multitude (those evangelized by the 144,000 Jews) that no one could number crying out with a loud voice, "Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!"
- 2nd Level (v.11) - all the angels were standing around the throne and,
- 3rd Level (v.11-12) - the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God saying, "Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! Amen."

Revelation 7:13-17

- Rev 7:13 Then one of the elders addressed me, saying, “Who are these, clothed in white robes, and from where have they come?”
- Rev 7:14 I said to him, “Sir, you know.” And he said to me, “These are the ones coming out of the great tribulation. They have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.
- Rev 7:15 “Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple; and he who sits on the throne will shelter them with his presence.
- Rev 7:16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; the sun shall not strike them, nor any scorching heat.
- Rev 7:17 For the Lamb in the midst of the throne will be their shepherd, and he will guide them to springs of living water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.”
