Chronology of the 7 Seals Judgment



1st Seal White Horse - PEACE

2nd Seal Red Horse – WORLD WAR

3rd Seal Black Horse - FAMINE

4th Seal Pale Horse - DEATH

5th Seal - PLEA FOR JUDGMENT

6th Seal - CATAclysm

The 144,000 Jews Servants of God

- Rev 7:4 And I heard the number of the sealed, 144,000, sealed from every tribe of the sons of Israel:
- Rev 7:5 12,000 from the tribe of **Judah** were sealed, 12,000 from the tribe of **Reuben**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Gad**,
- Rev 7:6 12,000 from the tribe of **Asher**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Naphtali**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Manasseh**,
- Rev 7:7 12,000 from the tribe of **Simeon**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Levi**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Issachar**,
- Rev 7:8 12,000 from the tribe of **Zebulun**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Joseph**, 12,000 from the tribe of **Benjamin** were sealed.

The Meanings of Blowing of Trumpets in the Bible

- To call the chiefs of the tribe of Israel and the congregation to start the journey of the camps of Israel. (Numbers 10:1-6)
- That they may be remembered before the Lord when they go to war against the enemy that oppresses the people of Israel (Numbers 10:9) cf. Figurative blowing of the trumpet to warn people of their sins because of the coming judgment of the Lord([Ezekiel 33:1-7)
- To celebrate the appointed feasts of the Lord with gladness and the beginning of months
- The 7 angels blow the trumpets of heaven against the earth just as Joshua and the 7 priests and their 7 trumpets of ram's horns blew their trumpets before the Lord to the destruction of the city of Jericho.

The Trumpet Judgments

- **1st Trumpet:** hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth:
 - **2nd Trumper:** a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea:
 - **3rd Trumpet:** a great burning star (Wormwood) from heaven fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters;
 - **4th Trumpet:** the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars;. so as the third part of them was darkened,
- the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.
 - the third part of the sea became blood; the third part of the living creatures in the sea died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.
 - the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters because they were made bitter.
 - and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise
